Assessment system of learning outcomes

The grading system includes: current control carried out during the semester during lectures and seminars, the student's success in the discipline is assessed by the sum of points scored (maximum amount - 60 points; minimum amount that allows a student to take the exam - 35 points); modular control, which is carried out taking into account the current control in the form of written control work; final / semester control, which is conducted in the form of an exam in accordance with the schedule of the educational process (maximum number - 40 points, minimum number of credits - 25 points).
