# **Assessment system of learning outcomes**

The system of students' developed competencies assessment includes all types of study activities according to the curriculum of the discipline. There are lectures, seminars, practical lessons, as well as independent training. Assessment of the students' developed competencies is carried out using a 100-point accumulation system. In accordance with the Regulations "About the Procedure for Assessing the Results of Students' Learning Based on the Accumulated Bulletin-Rating System" by S. Kuznets KhNEU, control measures include:

current control takes place at lectures and practical lessons (seminars), assessed by the total number of points gained during the semester (the maximal possible number is 60 points, the minimal required number is 35 points);

final control takes place at the end of each semester in the form of an exam (the maximal possible number is 40 points; the minimal required number is 25 points).
