Discipline policies

Policy on skipping classes: skipping classes without a good reason is not allowed, missed classes are completed by the student individually during consultations or remotely through the site of personal learning systems.

The procedure for re-conducting control measures is regulated by the following documents:

- 1) Temporary provision "On the procedure for assessing the learning outcomes of students on the cumulative scoring and rating system";
 - 2) "The order of liquidation of academic debts of students of KhNEU. S. Kuznets ».

According to these documents, the re-submission of an unsatisfactory assessment is allowed according to the re-schedule, but not more than twice. If there are good reasons, the transfer can be done on an individual schedule.
