Assessment system of learning outcomes

The final grade in the discipline is calculated taking into account the points obtained for the final tests, and the points obtained during the current control of the accumulative system. The total result in points for the semester is: "60 or more points - credited" (maximum number of points - 100), "59 or less points - not credited" and is entered in the test "Statement of success" of the discipline. In case of receiving less than 60 points, the student must pass the test after the end of the examination session within the period set by the dean of the faculty, but not later than two weeks after the beginning of the semester.
