# Learning outcomes assessment system

The system of assessment of formed competencies in students takes into account the types of classes, which according to the curriculum of the discipline include lectures, laboratory classes and



independent work. Assessment of the formed competencies of students is carried out according to the accumulative 100-point system. In accordance with the Provisional Regulation "On the procedure for assessing the learning outcomes of students on the cumulative scoring and rating system" KhNEU. S. Kuznets, control measures include:

current control, which is carried out during the semester during lectures, laboratory classes and is estimated by the amount of points scored (maximum amount - 60 points; the minimum amount that allows a student to take the exam - 35 points);

modular control, which is carried out taking into account the current control for the relevant content module and aims at an integrated assessment of student learning outcomes after studying the material from the logically completed part of the discipline - the content module;

final / semester control, which is carried out in the form of current-final control in accordance with the schedule of the educational process.
